Survey Methodology

- Data was collected from July 8 through July 10, 2024 by Panels LTD which has conducted over 10,000 surveys in Israel since its inception in 2006. The margin of sampling error is +/- 4.0% with a confidence level of 95%.
- The majority of the **612 respondents** (91%) were surveyed in Hebrew via the Panels LTD online panel which includes over 30,000 active Israeli members. This sample was supplemented with 9% telephone/cellphone surveys, 7% in Hebrew to ultra-orthodox communities and 3% in Russian to Russian speaking Israelis.
- Socio-demographic quotas of age, gender, geography, heritage and religiosity were based on the most up-to-date data from the Israeli Bureau of Statistics. A sleight weight was applied to the location and self-identified heritage of the survey.
- All numbers of .5 and higher are rounded up in this presentation.
- Respondents were filtered to likely voters by self identifying as having voted in the 2022 parliamentary elections in Israel (98% of respondents) or as having not been old enough to vote in 2022 but eligible to vote now (2% of respondents)
- While the language "likely Israeli voters" is used, it must be clear that **this data reveals the opinions of** Jewish voters only in Israel and not the opinions of Israeli Arabs who make up ~21% of the population




US-Israel Relationship




Older voters are more likely to have visited the US




Israeli men more likely to have visited the US than women








Israelis who have visited the US are more likely to believe the US-Israel relationship is important, versus those who have never visited

In your opinion, how important or not important do you think the State of Israel's relationship is with the United States? (by visit the US)






In your opinion, how important or not important do you think the State of Israel's relationship is with the United States? (by religiosity, Answer 'very important' and 'somewhat important' only)












Israeli men drive the small group who think US support is not critical to Israel's future



Majority of Israeli voters oppose a 2 State Solution






October 7 pushed nearly half of Israelis to oppose the 2 State Solution

In a hypothetical situation where Hamas in Gaza is eradicated, support for the 2 State Solution increases only from 20% to 26%


And if Israel will succeed in completely eradicating Hamas in Gaza, would you (ROTATE) support or oppose a two state solution? (RANDOMIZE)

And if Israel will succeed in completely eradicating Hamas in Gaza, would you (ROTATE) support or oppose a two state solution? (by religiosity)








Majority of all levels of religiosity support the Abraham Accords




Majority of all age groups support the Abraham Accords, with Israelis 55+ giving strongest support


Since October 7, would you say your opinion of the Abraham Accords has changed: (ROTATE TOP TO BOTTOM, BOTTOM TO TOP)


Do you support or oppose a future diplomatic agreement between Israel and Saudi Arabia? (ROTATE)





Gender gap in support for Israel-Saudi agreement


Do you support or oppose a future diplomatic agreement between Israel and Saudi Arabia? (by age)






Majority of all levels of religiosity support an Israel-Saudi Arabia agreement, with a strong support of 85% among secular Israelis

Do you support or oppose a future diplomatic agreement between Israel and Saudi Arabia? (by religiosity)




Majority of all age groups support an Israel-Saudi agreement, with support strongest amongst older Israelis






Breakdown of age groups of Israelis who served since October 7

Have you or someone in your family served in active duty or reserve duty since October 7? (by age, I served ONLY)




Percent within an age group that served since October 7 1/4 18-24 year olds, 1/5 25-34 year olds

Have you or someone in your family served in active duty or reserve duty since October 7? (by age, I served ONLY)




19% of Israeli voters say they or someone in their family evacuated their home since October 7

Groups with highest percent of Israelis who they or someone in their family evacuated their home since October 7


Have you or someone in your family been forced to evacuate your home since October 7? (by target groups, answering I evacuated and someone in my family evacuated, combined ONLY)

Have you or someone in your family been injured, killed or taken hostage on October 7, in security service since October 7, or as a result of terror since October 7?



Israelis want to see Israel or an international coalition that includes Arab countries govern Gaza in coming years


Thinking about the future of Gaza, who do you think should govern Gaza in the coming years? (RANDOMIZE)




Support for future Israeli control over Gaza driven by more religious Israelis

Thinking about the future of Gaza, who do you think should govern Gaza in the coming years? (by religiosity, answering Israel and coalition with Arab countries ONLY)





Majority of Israelis support escalation of IDF activity in north & ground invasion by IDF of Lebanon


Thinking about the northern border, do you support or oppose a significant escalation of IDF activity against Hezbollah, including a ground invasion of Lebanon? (ROTATE)




Gender divide in support for significant military escalation in north















Age of likely voters




Religiosity of likely voters

How would you define yourself religiously? Would you say you are ultra orthodox, orthodox, traditional, or secular? If you are not Jewish just say so.




Heritage of likely voters


Did you move from the Former Soviet Union after 1989?

Location of residence







Israeli Jewish Public Opinion Collected March 7-10, 2024: Low Support for the 2 State Solution





Institute for National Security Studies (Israel) Research carried out between March 7-10 2024 by the Rafi Smith Institute, during which 500 men and women were interviewed online, constituting a representative sample of the adult Jewish population in Israel aged 18 and over. The maximum margin of error for the sample is 4% with a 95% confidence level. Margin of error +/-3%



Should PA President Abbas Remain or Resign from office?




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HAMAS Remains Party Seen as Most Deserving to Lead






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HAMAS Leader Ismail Haniyeh Would Win an Election Against PA President Abbas




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Violence Against Israel Still Seen as Effective by Palestinians




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
Even After Oct. 7, Palestinians Support the Oct. 7 Massacre
